Date Fact and Amplifying Data

- 4311.. First indication that Korea will be divided after WWII concludes.
- 450808 USSR enters the war against Japan.
- 450811 Draft arrangement to partition Korea agreed upon by US and USSR.
- 450824 Soviet troops reach 38th Parallel.
- 450902 WWII (Great Patriotic War) ends.
- 450908 US troops land in Korea.
- 451010 Korean Workers Party (also known as the North Korean Bureau of the Korean Communist Party) founded by Kim Il-Sung; Kim named Chairman.
- 4512.. US-USSR-UK commission on the Korean government begins in Moscow.
- 4602.. Kim Il-Sung named Chairman of the Provisional Peoples' Committee of Korea.
- 4603 .. Commission adjourns without success in creating a workable government.
- 4608 Kim Il-Sung amalgamates KWP and New Peoples Party (Koreans from China).
- 4610.. US creates the South Korean Interim Legislative Assembly under Syngman Rhee.
- 4705.. Second commission on Korean government convenes in Seoul.
- 4707 Second commission on Korean government adjourns without success.
- 471114 UN moves a resolution for a united and independent Korea; free elections to be held in 1948.USSR objects.
- 4805 Free elections held in South Korea alone.
- 480720 Syngman Rhee government sworn in and Republic of Korea established.
- 480815 US government terminates operations; ROK takes over.
- 480909 Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea proclaimed by Kim Il-Sung in Pyongyang.
- 4812.. UN declares ROK to be the lawful government of Korea; KWP sponsored riots in the South attempt to invalidate UN declaration.
- 4903.. Kim Il Sung first requests support from Stalin to attack South Korea; it is denied.
- 4904 North Korean intelligence "feels" the South is preparing to attack them.
- 4905 DPRK troops attack across the DMZ near Kaesong.
- 490503 Stalin promises Kim Il Sung "technical assistance". Kim asks for sufficient arms as follows: Mechanized brigades of two tank regiments (33 x T-34-85), an SP arty battalion (16 x Su-76), an army artillery regiment (24 x Zis-3 76mm), and an independent tank battalion of Su-76s. He also requests a mixed aviation division of Assault Aviation and Fighter Aviation regiments (43 aircraft each)
- 490514 Mao Zedong returns two Korean divisions to Kim Il Sung.
- 490527 North Koreans fighting over the Ongjin Peninsula.
- 4906.. US troops finish pullout via Inchon; DPRK merges North and South branches of KWP into one single organization.
- 4907.. DPRK troops launch a second series of raids across the 38th Parallel.
- 490726 Mao asks Stalin if the Soviet Union will supply aircraft to the PRC 200 Yak fighters and 40-80 bombers are requested, plus pilot training.
- 490604 USSR begins weapons shipments in exchange for 30,000 tons of rice.
- 490814 Kim Il Sung again requests support in attacking the South.
- 490827 Stalin again rebuffs Kim Il Sung.
- 491004 Kim Il Sung informed of Stalin's decision.
- 491015 KPA wins some small victories along the 38th Parallel; USSR ambassador does not inform Stalin of these events.
- The first Yak-12 trainers arrive in China. By year's end, China will have over 185 Soviet built aircraft for the PLAAF.
- 491022 Stalin informed of events in Korea; Soviet ambassador censured.

- 500119 Kim Il Sung notes that now China is unified, it is his turn.
- 500213 50th IAD is moved to the Far East to begin teaching Chinese PLAAF pilots the MiG-15
- 500214 The USSR signs a treaty to provide a \$300 million loan for military aid to the PRC. The PLAAF ordered 289 La-9 fighters, 198 Tu-2 bombers, and 108 trainers and other aircraft. The next day, Mao requests another 628 aircraft.
- 5004.. Kim Il Sung and Stalin meet; Stalin, counting on his possession of nuclear weapons as a deterrent to US action, agrees to Kim's request.
- 5005.. Kim Il Sung and Mao Zedong discuss events; Mao promises to aid Kim only if the Japanese come the war on the side of the South.
- 5006.. PLAAF deploys its first combined aviation brigade including 38 MiG-15, 39 La-11, 39 Tu-2 bombers, 25 Il-10 ground attack aircraft, and 14 Yak-12 trainers.
- 500603 DPRK begins call for "peaceful unification through elections".
- 500619 DPRK reiterates call for "peaceful unification through elections".
- 500620 North Koreans claim to have intercepted South Korean attack plans.
- 500621 Kim Il Sung notes the South Koreans are expecting a North Korean offensive.
- 500622 DPRK divisional attack orders drafted and transmitted to first echelon forces.
