**27.07.41: Ju 88 A-4** shot down by D. Ledovskiy: W.Nr. (construction-number) 881128, unit: 4./KG 51 "Edelweiss".

Whole crew killed: Obergefreiter Kurt Kutschbach, Unterofizier Waltr Krause, Gefreiter Rudolf Bertera, Gefreiter Gerhard Berger.

**02.08.41: He 111 H-6** shot down by N. Scherbina, unit: 2./KG 53 "Legion Condor".

Whole crew killed: Feldwebel Max Brunzel, Obergefreiter Heinz Berkenbaum, Gefreiter Gerhard Band, Gefreiter Alfred Greulich, Gefreiter Rudolf Meier.

**27.08.41: Ju 88 A** shot down by D. Ledovskiy: unit: KG 1 "Hindenburg".

**29.08.41: "Do 215"** shot down by N. Krasil'nikov was in fact the similar **Do 17 Z**, unit: Staff/KG 2 "Holzhammer". Force-landed. Crew unhurt: Oberleutnant Werner Lutter (pilot), scout (unknown), Unteroffizier Bremer (radio-operator), Stabsfeldwebel Fritz Hoyer (flight engineer).

**04.07.42: Bf 109 F-4** "taraned" by K. Potapov: W.Nr. 7194, unit: I./JG 3 "Udet".

Pilot: Hauptmann Karl-Friedrich Bertram, was wounded by a bullet in his thigh, which resulted in his leg having to be amputated a few weeks later. Bertram was the Adjutant of I./JG 3 "Udet". He was credited with 10 victories (his last two victories were two Bostons on 3 July 1941). On 4 July 1942, Hptm. Bertram was shot down in aerial combat (most probably by K. Potapov) near Voronezh in his Bf 109 F-4 (W.Nr. 7194). He sustained a severe wound in his thigh and his leg had to be amputated a few weeks later. He never saw combat service again.

### **Hauptmann Karl-Friedrich Bertram**

In October 1941, the "old" I./JG 3 was withdrawn from the Russian front and transferred to Germany, where it was re-named as the new II./JG 1 of the Home Defence Air Force. Instead, a completely new I./JG 3 was formed in Germany early in 1942.

The Gruppenkommandeur (commander) of the new I./JG 3 "Udet" was Hauptmann Georg Michalek, a veteran from II./JG 3, who had scored 37 victories and was awarded with the Knight's Cross. But the majority of the pilot staff of Michalek's I./JG 3 was made up of newly trained fighter pilots - including the Adjutant Hauptmann Karl-Friedrich Bertram.

At the end of April 1942, I./JG 3 was transferred to Russia. On 6 May 1942, I./JG 3 was sent to Zuerichtal in the Crimea to take part in the new offensive against the Kerch Peninsula. Two days later, I./JG 3 flew on its first combat missions. On 8 May 1942, Hptm. Michalek shot down a MiG-3 as the unit's first victory. Karl-Friedrich Bertram soon proved to be one of the most talented young fighter pilots of this new unit. This is his victory list:

7. 28 June 1942 1844 hrs., 1 Il-2 east of Kursk.
8. 2 July 1942 1638 hrs., 1 Il-2 east of Kursk.
9. 3 July 1942 0935 hrs., 1 Boston east of Kursk.
10. 3 July 1942 0945 hrs., 1 Boston east of Kursk.

On 4 July 1942, Hptm. Bertram was shot down in aerial combat (most probably by K. Potapov) near Voronezh in his Bf 109 F-4 (W.Nr. 7194). He sustained a severe wound in his thigh and his leg had to be amputated a few weeks later. He never saw combat service again.

**28.07.42: Ju 88 D-5** shot down by V. Kotsar and Kostin: W.Nr. 430023, call-code: 4U+AL, unit: 3.(F)/123 (a reconnaissance unit).

**29.08.42: 2 Ju 88 D-1** shot down by H. Hanipov, (Romahov); A. Eldishev and L. Efimov: W.Nr. 430318, unit: 2.(F)/22; W.Nr. 881527, call-code: 4U+CL, unit: 3.(F)/123.

**01.06.43: 3 Fw 190** shot down by P. Kalujniy; P. Kalujniy and A. Isaenko; N. Krasilnikov and I. Romanenko: One of these Fw 190 was piloted by Oberfeldwebel Heinz Leber (unit: 2./JG 51 "Molders"). Leber, who was killed, was an ace with 54 victories.

**Heinz Leber**, born 14 May 1920, Ahlendorf/Thuringen.

From March 1941 he was with the I./JG 51. He scored his first victory on 2 July 1941 on the Eastern Front. Leber was most famous for a large number of fighter-bomber sorties. In total, he flew 428 combat sorties and achieved 54 confirmed victories - all on the Eastern Front. For some time he was active as a fighter instructor. Back in first-line service with 2./JG 51 (commanded by Hauptmann Edwin Thiel, a Knight's Cross holder with 76 victories) as an Oberfeldwebel, Heinz Leber was shot down and killed by Russian anti-aircraft fire at 200 m flight altitude near Mtsensk on 1 June 1943. He was promoted to Leutnant posthumously and was awarded with the Knight's Cross posthumously on 29 February 1944.

**08.06.43: Bf 109 G-4** shot down by P. Krivin: W.Nr. 14 858, call-code: / (black) 2 + - / , unit: 5./JG 3 "Udet",

Pilot: Obergefreiter Heinz Welsch (probably no victories), missing.

**10.08.43: Ju 88 A** shot down by I. Matushin and J. Chehovskoy: unit: 9./KG 51 "Edelweiss"

One crew member - Obergefreiter Willy Kahnenbey killed.

(I am not 100% certain that this was the aircraft shot down by 146 GvIAP.)

**05.05.44: He 111** shot down by Ivanov: unit: 6./KG 55 "Greif"

Two crew members wounded: Unteroffizier Eugen Kaiser (scout) and Feldwebel Karl Linnenbruegger (flight engineer).
